
**Dear Fellow Tinmoggers,**

At last, a TINMOG NEWSLETTER!

Another month has gone by, it can't be long before some relaxation of the regulations begins. I trust you are all well, though I suspect many of you are getting a little bored now, especially as we are not allowed to meet with family and friends.

Since my last email, I have attended National Centre Secretary Meeting, via Zoom of course, and there were 36 attendees, far more than attended these meetings in person. It was a short meeting, four and a half hours with a 20-minute break for lunch. Most of the meeting was spent on how to celebrate the 70th Anniversary of the MSCC and Secretaries have gone away to deliberate on the subject. There was also a short discussion on the new CSIP, what is a CSIP you may ask, it's the Centre Secretary Information Pack. The CSIP sets out what is required of a Centre Secretary, along with advice. It was decided that with all the current laws on data protection, safeguarding etc that a separate meeting should be held to include two elected Centre Secretaries and national Officers to produce a draft CSIP for us all to go through before the Pack is adopted. I asked that Centre Secretaries should know, in words of one syllable, what is expected of Clubs with regards to Risk Assessments, would we need one for a lunch run, meeting for a Noggin, etc? Without clear guidelines, and hopefully sample Risk Assessments, we could invalidate the MSCC insurance policy should, heaven forbid, an incident occurred during a Club event - I will keep you informed.

Last Thursday evening, your Committee held a Zoom Committee Meeting. We discussed future events, Noggin and quiz evenings, and the AGM.



## EVENTS

When the current restrictions have been reduced, and we are allowed to meet up, we thought that the first Club get together could be a ***lunch meeting at the Crown at Lanlivery*** as the venue is quite central for members and they dealt with us at our last get together with regard to the Covid regulations. We felt that it is more likely that a meal could take place with some form of social distancing than just meeting for drinks in the evening at a pub.

***Noggin and Quiz evening by Zoom*** – we will continue to have these evenings once a month, drink in hand or no drink in hand, and the next will be on the Thursday, 25th of February, followed by another on Thursday, 25th March, with our thanks to Max. Fiona now makes regular visits to the Noggin, the pub Noggin was rather too far to drive from Northumberland! Members will be asked to send items

for discussion at the AGM, and Officers reports will be sent for you to read – I can say that these will probably be shorter than usual this year. The Committee has recommended that the Membership fee for the year 2021 to 2022 be reduced by £5 to zero. This will of course have to be approved by members at the AGM. The membership renewal forms will still have to be completed.
